BEAR HUNTS

With the bear population at a record high and steadily climbing, there are great opportunities for the hunter wishing to harvest the elusive black bear. Our bear hunts are conducted over active baits. Each one of our stands is carefully tended to, and caters to firearm or archery hunters. The Oxbow Lodge takes great pride in selecting and maintaining bear sites. We have multiple bears coming to each site well before the season begins. With a huge hunting area and an abundance of active bait sites with limited hunting pressure, you will be assured productive hunting throughout the season.

All stands and blinds are set up in key locations with ample cover for both bear and hunter. Bowhunters should expect shots no farther than 20 yards, and most gun stands are set within 40 to 60 yards.

We attribute our success to a number of factors. Hunter concealment and prevailing wind play a major part in our stand locations along with our time-proven methods of baiting.

Oxbow Lodge bear hunts include:

- Six days of hunting and seven nights lodging with all meals and linens
- Daily housekeeping services
- All baiting, stands and preparation for hunting site location
- Transportation, if needed, to hunting area
- Full guide service, tracking and recovery of your bear
- All game preparation including field dressing, skinning, cutting, wrapping and freezing of meat
- Registration of game

DEER HUNTING

If you have ever reached your deer stand well before daylight only to share the morning light with an army of orange clad hunters, or driven hours to your stand just to find someone else occupying your spot, Oxbow, Maine is the place for you. The whitetail deer that occupy the area around Oxbow are nothing short of trophy class. With good genetics and limited hunting pressure, many bucks reach maturity and become that "Trophy Buck". Bucks reaching over 200 pounds dressed are not uncommon, with a few bucks in the state reaching over an incredible 300 pounds.

For the hunter who looking for a deer hunting experience rich in tradition and is willing to hunt a little harder to harvest that well earned trophy, the Oxbow Lodge welcomes you.

MOOSE HUNTING

No animal is more symbolic of Maine's northern forests than the moose. A large bull may be as tall as 7 ft. at the shoulder and weigh 3/4 ton. Maine has more moose per square mile than anywhere else in North America.

Our guided moose hunts are conducted in a traditional manner by calling, spotting and stalking. We take pride in the pursuit of trophy-class animals. Our guides spend much of the summer scouting bulls that we will be pursuing. Whether hunting with modern day rifle, muzzleloader, handgun or archery equipment while floating a river in a canoe or calling from the edge of a bog, the memories of a close encounter with these monarchs of the North will last a lifetime.
